

Campaign Against New Town CANT

A Team of representatives from North Elmham and neighbouring parishes has been set up to oppose the proposals by development company Lanpro to build 10,000 homes in the open countryside. Those proposals appear to be hitched on to the idea that the Mid Norfolk Railway line from County School will take everyone far and wide in the area and even in the country! The proposals are being considered at the Breckland Council meeting on Thursday 25th October in Dereham. Lanpro are, as well, seeking to obtain consent by dealing directly with central government, in other words jumping over the planning system and local democracy.

CANT has dropped leaflets to householders urging residents to write letters of objection to all Breckland Councillors as well as the Government Office.

CANT has arranged transport to the Meeting in Dereham on 25th October.

CANT has a Team meeting planned for Tuesday 9th October at 7.30 p.m. in the Sports Pavilion at North Elmham. We will be discussing the planned visit to the Breckland Council meeting on 25th October, and other actions that can be taken to kick this proposal into touch. CANT remains concerned that even if Breckland Council does not support the proposal LANPRO will lobby Government.
